### **TERMS & CONDITIONS**

### Entries

Entries must be submitted to the show secretary by email or post using the supplied entry form, <u>no later than Friday 3</u>
<u>November</u>. Late entries may be accepted at the discretion of the Jersey Classic committee, but the higher late entry fee will apply.

## **Entry fees**

Entry fees must accompany the entry form and are charged on a per cow, per class basis.

### Stock arrival

For those travelling from out of town, stock will be permitted on site from Friday 18 November (day prior).

### **Animal health**

TB testing – All cattle entered for this show must be from a TB free herd. Where a herd is from a declared movement control area, cattle (including young stock) must be tested and cleared within 60 days of movement. A copy of the Test Certificate must accompany all entry forms, and checks will be made of TB declaration cards upon arrival of stock. All animals must comply with current Animal Health Board regulations.

### NAIT

All exhibitors must comply with NAIT regulations. A NAIT approved RFID tag is mandatory for all movements, and it is the responsibility of exhibitors to record the movement of exhibited stock to and from the Jersey Classic NAIT Number - 545952.

### Substitutes

Substitutes will only be accepted for cattle in the same breed and same aged class.

### Disqualification

Any alteration of conformation of cattle will be considered malpractice and will result in disqualification from the event.

### Prizes

All prizes will be in the form of cash, vouchers or product to the value listed in the show schedule.

### **General rules**

Genetic realisation: Points will be awarded for BW ranging from 100-150 (50 points), PW ranging from 200 – 250 (50 points), and Type (50 points). Indexes supplied should be current as at the latest AE run. Where the class results in a tie, the animals total indexes will be added together to split the animals.

Three female's in-milk: at least two must be in milk and all animals must be milked in same herd but family ownership permitted.

Junior group of three: - any combination of calves and/or yearlings.

Novice cow: Entries must be owned by a Te Awamutu club member, and cow must not have won a champion or reserve. "Novice Breeder: Breeder must not have won an inmilk championship or reserve."

Senior calf/yearling (born from 1 June - 31 July inclusive)

Junior calf/yearling (born 1 August)

Junior members: 15 and under on show day

McGregor challenge: Open to junior members within the TA club area. The entry must be led by the exhibitor and must not be clipped. The class will be judged on the best reared, presented and handled entry.

Unless already stated above, the standard rules of the Agricultural Society will apply. The Jersey Classic committee reserves the right to alter the terms and conditions at any time without notice, including amalgamation of classes with insufficient entries or extend classes with very large entries. Any decision made by the committee will be final and no correspondence will be entered into.

- 5. 6 & 7 year olds in milk (1<sup>st</sup> \$100, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$50, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$30, 4<sup>th</sup> \$20)
- 6. 8 years and over in milk (1<sup>st</sup> \$100, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$50, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$30, 4<sup>th</sup> \$20)

- 8. Genetic realisation (1<sup>st</sup> \$75, 2<sup>nd</sup> \$35, 3<sup>rd</sup> \$25, 4<sup>th</sup> \$15)

  Points will be awarded for BW ranging from 100-150 (50 points), PW ranging from 200-250 (50 points), and Type (50 points). Indexes supplied should be current as at the latest AE run.
- 9. Dam & daughter OR two daughters of one dam (1st \$75, 2nd \$35, 3rd \$25, 4th \$15)
- 10. Three females  $(1^{st} \$75, 2^{nd} \$35, 3^{rd} \$25, 4^{th} \$15)$

At least two must be in milk and all animals must be milked in the same herd but family ownership is permitted.

11. Novice cow (1<sup>st</sup> - \$75, 2<sup>nd</sup> - \$35, 3<sup>rd</sup> - \$25, 4<sup>th</sup> - \$15)

Entries must be owned by a Te Awamutu club member, and cow must not have won a champion or reserve.

(Rosettes will also be awarded to highest placed Novice Breeder entries within this class.)

Young stock entry fees: \$6 per entry per class, Late entry fees (received after 6/11) \$9 per entry per class

Junior Female Champion (Champion - \$60, Reserve - \$40)
