- · Publications- Booklets, Book,
- · Jersey Ambassadors support/training/travel/materials
- Education/Seminars/Member Events
- Support for JerseyNZ lead research or an organization undertaking research of benefit for Jersey
- Jersey Club liaison and support

LEGAL ADVICE

You are welcome to discuss your bequest plans with the Chair of the JerseyNZ Board of Directors.

'I give, free of all duties, to The New Zealand Jersey Cattle Breeders Association (Incorporated 1902), the sum of \$.....

To be used and applied for general purposes at the discretion of the JerseyNZ Board of Directors.

Or

To be directed for use in the area ofunder the guidance of the JerseyNZ Board of Directors.
