KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



Dr Steve Little

Steve Little, of Capacity+ Ag Consulting, is an Australian veterinarian with additional qualifications in ruminant nutrition and agribusiness management. He is an honorary fellow and chief examiner of the Australian Association of Ruminant Nutrition. He is also a past president of the Australian Association of Ruminant Nutrition and the Cattle Chapter of the Australian and New Zealand College of Veterinary Scientists. Steve has extensive experience as a farm advisor, providing herd nutrition, reproduction, health and productivityadvice, and as a consultant to animal nutrition and health companies, other commercial agribusinesses and public sector research and development organisations.

He has led or contributed to many R & D projects and extension programs in Australia including InCalf, feed.FIBRE.future, Feed2Milk, Cool Cows and Feeding the Genes. Steve also developed the Advanced Nutrition in Action training program for dairy farmers and advisors now being delivered across Australia by Dairy Australia. Steve recently led Jersey Australia's flagship project - Jersey the Most Profitable and Sustainable Cow. He will join us from Australia via Zoom.



Tangaroa Walker

Tangaroa Walker is the creator of 'Farm 4 Life'- a social media platform that educates his viewers about farming life.

Tangaroa started off farming by helping his Uncle to milk the cows and feed the pigs and dogs. He did this to the age of 12 and for \$5 a week. That is where it all started but he thinks the passion probably comes from bridging the gap and wanting people to understand where food comes from and what happens on farm. Tangaroa loves using social media and hearing from different people interested in farming. His aim is to bring new faces to the Southland and NZ dairy industry.

Farm 4 Life came about in 2012 when Tangaroa won the Ahuwhenua young Maori Farmer of the Year award. A friend then encouraged him to start the page and that's where the journey began. Helping others to learn is Tangaroa's passion – no matter where you come from, you do the mahi, you can make it happen.



Rob Scott

Rob Scott was elected Mayor of Southland District Council in 2022 and has some big plans in store for the region. He never saw himself as a politician until he was approached and asked to join the Lumsden Community Board in 2010. Rob says he understands farming and the importance of the rural voice and the role it plays in Southland's success.

Scott lives in Lumsden with his wife and two kids. He runs two businesses and has a number of community interests, including the Volunteer Fire Brigade and is a founding member of the Lumsden Heritage Trust. He previously worked in IT and Finance in Wellington after graduating

from Otago University with a BCom. Scott says "My passion for the communities of Southland has been an enduring feature of my role as councillor and has progressed to a strong desire to lead Southland and its great communities into the future. I care deeply about the people, I care deeply about the place and I care deeply about the potential!"
