KEYNOTE SPEAKERS



Hon. Todd McClay

Hon Todd McClay is MP for Rotorua, NZ Minister of Agriculture, Trade, Forestry, Hunting and Fishing and Assoc Foreign Affairs. He was first elected to Parliament in 2008 after winning the Rotorua seat from the Labour Government with a majority of more than 5,000 votes.

In 2017 he received the highest vote and majority in the history of the Rotorua seat and in 2020 he was the first MP in 24 years to have been elected for a fifth term as Rotorua's MP.

Mr McClay has been a Cabinet minister in two National-led governments and has held the portfolios of Minister of Trade, of State-Owned Enterprises, and of Revenue. He has also been the Associate Minister of Health, of Tourism, of Trade, and of Foreign Affairs.



Mea Motu

Mea is not just a formidable force in the boxing ring, she is a symbol of resilience, courage and triumph. Mea's interest in boxing started at just 13 years old and has grown into a very impressive boxing career. In April 2023, at the age of 33 and a proud mother of five, Mea firmly secured her place in history as the IBO World Super Bantamweight Champion. This didn't come without it's challenges and the story of what she's been through, how she found the courage and strength to fight through it and coming out the other side to become a World Champion is incredibly powerful.

Mea has embraced a role as an ambassador for 'I Am Hope' and is a beacon of hope for those grappling with mental health. Mea openly speaks about her truth and how she has risen to overcome the difficulties and dark aspects of her life in the hope to inspire and uplift others.

Mea Motu's life is a narrative of triumph over adversity, a testament to the strength that resides within each of us. Hear of Mea's victories through a resounding message that no challenge is insurmountable.



Dr Jacqueline Rowarth

Jacqueline Rowarth has a Bachelor's Degree in Agricultural Science with honours in Environmental Agriculture, and a PhD in Soil Science from Massey University. She has worked in research, education, management and governance with Agresearch, Lincoln University, Unitec in Auckland, The University of Melbourne, Massey University, University of Waikato, the Environmental Protection Authority, Crop and Food Research, AGMARDT and DairyNZ.

She is a Past President of the New Zealand Institute of Agricultural and Horticultural Science, and of the New Zealand Grassland Association. She is a frequent contributor to public debate in the media and speaks to industry, society and school groups whenever invited.

Jacqueline remains committed to trying to help society understand the importance of agriculture and horticulture, and dispelling the myths that surround food production.

Chloe completed the JerseyNZ Governance Development programme and after being a long-standing member, successfully went on to be appointed Chair of the New Zealand Young Farmers (NZYF). Chloe is the Regional Operations Manager for the Upper North Island at Fonterra, as well as running their fencing business with husband, Cory.

Sara Russell

Sara, a Synlait Gold Elite Dairy Farmer, is a member of Dairy NZ Environment Leaders and a Climate Change Ambassador. A passionate Jersey breeder, Sara is a member of the JerseyNZ Governance Development Programme and has the motivation to take a step forward and be more involved in the governance of dairy specific entities.
