The exhibiting of all Dairy Cattle in New Zealand is governed by the RAS Dairy Cattle Show Code of Ethics document. This document is Appendixes to the Additional Rules for Showing – Specific Sections pages 21-35.

#### **Entry**

- Entries to be submitted on online at www.main-events.com or forward the official Entry Form to Office.
- Entries close with the Secretary on Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> November 2025.
- Entry fees are \$25.00 per class per animal, unless stated, GST incl, a Tax Invoice/Receipt is available.
- > Late entries fee is \$40.00 per class per animal, and will not be shown in the Catalogue.
- The Dairy Ethics committee has imposed a levy of \$5.00+GST per in-milk cow, which is to be paid with entry
- After close off of entries, if there are less than five (5) animals and/or three (3) exhibitors entered in the classes/sections, the Committee may then amalgamate classes/sections as necessary. The decision of the Stratford A & P Assn is final.
- > Gate Entry Exhibitors will receive a 'One Adult One Day' ticket, for every animal entered.

#### **Privacy Act**

The Association holds records of names, addresses, photographs and videos of members, exhibitors and exhibits including livestock and will publish these for the purpose of Show media reports or promotion.

#### **Health & Safety**

- All exhibitors accept the Association's conditions of entry and indemnify the Association under the provisions of the Health and Safety in Employment Act 2015 and subsequent amendments.
- > Each exhibitor must supervise and control their animals at all times and shall be liable.
- Exhibitors must comply with the appropriate current animal legislation within NZ.
- It is the Association's policy to see that all due care is taken to protect property.
- Persons occupying grandstands, buildings, other structures do so at their own risk, and no claim shall be made against the Association.
- > Parking is entirely at the owners' own risk.
- No alcohol to be consumed outside the sheds during judging.
- No loud music or noise after 10pm.
- Animals are not to be removed from the grounds prior to 3.00pm on Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> & Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2025, without an exemption from the Chairman of the Section.
- Animals to be stalled by 7.00am both Saturday 29<sup>th</sup> and Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> November 2025.

#### <u>Protests / Behaviour & Conduct / Complaint</u>

- In-Line RAS Resolution Process will be followed for all inappropriate behavior by exhibitor, competitor, member, official, spectator; exhibitor competitor rule breakage, animal abuse etc.
- > The sanctions of YELLOW CARD for warning and RED CARD for penalty/expulsion will be used.
- Every objection or protest must be made in writing, signed by the person making such complaint, and delivered to the Show Secretary.

#### **Type & Production Classes**

A + B – C formula based on Fonterra Co-Operative Group previous seasons payout. Production certificates for either last year or most previous season completed lactation (305) days MUST accompany entry forms otherwise entry will not be accepted (Kgs fat + Kgs protein + litres milk must be included). A Maximum of 100 points for type and additional production figures over and above the standard .2 of a point for each \$5.00 of additional production value. Standards are: two year old, 280kg Milk Solids: three year olds, 315 Kgs Milk Solids: four year olds, 355 Kgs Milk Solids: five year olds, 390 Kgs Milk Solids.

#### **Prize Money**

- > Prize Money (shown as e.g. PM \$100, 60, 30, 20, 10,) & Ribbons are awarded to each class for placings.
- The return of unwanted ribbons is appreciated by Stratford A&P.

All prize money will be paid out after the show into a nominated bank account, please enter details on the entry form. This will be done (subject to any queries) within 30 days of the final show day

#### Tie

In the event of a tie for final placings:

**Scenario one-** If two breeds are represented in the tie, the remaining two breed judges will toss a coin, the winning judge's card/ decision will be used

**Scenario two**- If only one breed is represented the remaining three judges will toss a coin, the winning judge's card/ decision will be used

#### **Points**

- Points in the Dairy Section will be awarded as follows:
  - o In Milk = 1st 10pts; 2nd 8pts; 3rd 6pts; 4th 4pts; 5th 2pts;
  - Dry = 1st 6pts; 2nd 4pts; 3rd 2pts; 4th 1pts;
  - o Championship 2 points and Reserve Champion 1 point.

#### **Cattle Rules**

- Animal Listing report or similar to be provided with entry.
- Proof of production for production classes MUST accompany entry.
- All animals entered in Breed and All Breed Classes must be entered in respective age classes.
- All animals entered in All Breed Section must be entered in Breed Sections.
- All animals must be named on entry form, with the exception of pairs or groups where an "ENTRY" will be accepted.
- Senior Calves and Senior Yearlings born after the 1st June.
- Junior Calves and Junior Yearlings born after the 10th August.
- Exhibits that are unplaced may be removed on the first day of the show.
- Cattle tags numbers not returned by Exhibitor will be charged at \$5.00 each.
- Clipping frames will be allocated within the exhibitors stalling area, subject to available space. A fee of \$60 per frame is payable on entry forms, No consideration will be given to any request after the closing of entries.
- Milking Shed is available, however it is recommended that own milking plant equipment is used.
- No cattle to be brought on to the grounds before Thursday 27<sup>th</sup> November 2025, unless prior request approved by the Dairy Section Chairman, and must be stalled in the exhibitors allocated stall area.
- Paddock grazing will NOT be available.
- ➤ Haylage is available, Sawdust will be used for bedding. No straw allowed
- > Skip bins will be provided and must be used by exhibitors to dispose of dung, uneaten hay etc.
- It is the responsibility of Exhibitors to supply and must use **R C D Units.** All electrical equipment and extension cords must be tested and tagged by an approved registered electrician.

#### **Disease Control T.B. Status**

As per the current Biosecurity requirements:

All stock covered by the NAIT and TBfree New Zealand schemes (regardless of age) must be:-

- > Departing from a property that is registered with a NAIT number and TBfree NZ herd number
- Accompanied with a copy of a valid Animal Status Declaration form
- Fitted with a valid and readable NAIT RFID tag and registered in the NAIT system.
- Registered in a movement to the event NAIT number from the animal's current NAIT number within 48 hours of arrival.
- Registered in a return movement from the event NAIT number to their destination (receiving NAIT number) within 48 hours of departure.
- Farmers MUST record the event movement as noted above. For assistance contact NAIT on 0800 482 463 or send an email to info@nait.co.nz.
- TB documentation. One copy of which will be collected by the chief steward upon the arrival of the cattle. Cattle will be scanned into the showgrounds.
- All cattle and their welfare are the responsibility of their owner while on show grounds.
- Please bring your own water feeders for your cattle, no troughs available.
   All stock over 90 days of age travelling from within a TBfree Movement Control Area must be:-
- Pre-movement tested with 60 days of arriving at the event
- All cattle entering the showgrounds must be NAIT tagged and registered, and be accompanied by appropriate paperwork




