## RULES

The Marcus Trotter Award is open to JerseyNZ Junior members who show their animals at A & P Shows, clubs shows and other dairy events.

### CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY:

- Entrants must enter the competition by 1 October each year. On receiving the entry, JerseyNZ will send a booklet for each animal entered to fill in at each event. The booklet must be filled in by the entrant and verified by either a steward, show secretary or judge present at the show.
- Entrants may enter multiple animals.
- Animals do not have to be owned by the entrant.
- Clipping is permitted and there is no restriction as to whether this is carried out by the Junior member concerned or by some other person.
- Classes at the following events are eligible for the calculation of points:
  - Any open, novice and junior classes at A & P Shows
  - Jersey Club shows and Jersey Club field days
  - Recognised events such as NZ Dairy Event and Jersey Classic
- Classes at the following events are NOT eligible for the calculation of points:
  - any calf club classes at school or at A & P Shows.
- Any animals to contribute points for the Marcus Trotter Award must be registered with JerseyNZ at the time the award placings are calculated.

- While Junior members may require some adult help when completing this application form, it is expected that the application will be completed in full by the Junior member entering.
- Points are awarded only when the entrant leads the animal into the judging ring.
- Completed booklets are to be returned to the JerseyNZ office by 30th April 2027.

### POINT CALCULATIONS:

#### Dry stock classes (this includes both female calves and bulls):

1st place: 3 points for each placing received  
2nd place: 2 points for each placing received  
3rd place: 1 point for each placing received

#### Milk classes:

1st place: 6 points for each placing received  
2nd place: 4 points for each placing received  
3rd place: 2 points for each placing received

#### Championship:

Champion: 2 points  
Reserve: 1 point

There are no points awarded where the animal is included in a group of animals (for example 3 by one sire, a young stock group or pair of heifer calves).

All entrants will be sent a competition card for sign off for all local and show participation.  
Cards must be returned by 30th April 2027 to complete your entry.
